The above approval is subject to the rectification of the following deficiencies latest by 31st August, 2007 to Director of Technical Education and a copy of the same to this Regional Office.

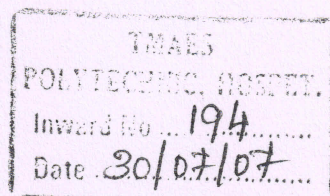
- Faculty with proper cadre ratio, requisite qualifications and experience to be appointed in all the disciplines as per AICTE Norms. Ratio between Senior lecturer and lecturer should be 1: 3 and faculty in teacher student ratio of 1:20 should be provided.

The additional intake is being granted based on the recommendations of the State Level Committee. It may be noted that all facilities including additional built up area and appointment of faculty should be made available before the commencement of the next academic session. Random surprise inspection would be carried out to verify facilities and if the institute is found deficient in fulfillment of norms & standards of AICTE, appropriate action would be initiated by the Council.

All other terms and conditions mentioned in the letter referred above, remain unchanged.
